

BRUSH & YARD WASTE

SCHEDULE FOR 2020:

April 13th May 11th

June 8th

September 14th October 12th

Collection will be completed on each public street once per cycle.

Place materials curbside by 7 AM.

MATERIALS COLLECTED

- **Brush**: Sticks & branches up to 6" in diameter. No length restriction.
- Yard Waste: Garden waste, leaves, landscaping prunings.

MATERIALS NOT COLLECTED

- Brush mixed with yard waste
- Firewood, Logs, Lumber
- Collected grass clippings
- Root balls, stumps, wood chips

Dirt, sod, rocks

Firewood, Logs, Lumber

COLLECTION GUIDELINES

- → Be sure that sticks and branches are not mixed in the same pile with yard waste or leaves.
- → Place the cut ends of branches facing the street.
- Do not tie brush into bundles.
- Keep drainage areas, roadways & sidewalks clear.
- → Avoid placing materials near stationary objects (e.g., mailboxes, fences, hydrants, utility poles, parked cars, trees).
- → Materials generated by commercial tree & landscaping services must be disposed by the company.

NO OPEN BURNING

East Buffalo Township is required under Act 101 of 1988 to implement recycling programs.

Commercial and Institutional establishments are required to recycle glass, corrugated cardboard and high-grade office paper.

Residents are required, by Township ordinance, to recycle, at a minimum, glass, aluminum, newspaper, plastics, leaves, and tree and shrub waste.
