EAST BUFFALO TOWNSHIP **RECYCLING GUIDE FALL 2023 - SPRING 2024**

East Buffalo Township is required under Act 101 of 1988 to implement recycling programs. Commercial and Institutional establishments are required to recycle glass, corrugated cardboard, and high-grade office paper.

Residents are required, by Township ordinance, to recycle, at a minimum, glass, aluminum, newspaper, plastics, leaves, tree, and shrub waste.

MATERIALS NOT COLLECTED



LEAVE COLLECTION

FIRST COLLECTION of the LEAVE CYCLE will begin on October 9, 2023. The Crew will rotate through the Township on a continual basis throughout October and November. FINAL **COLLECTION of the LEAVE CYCLE** will be the week of Monday, December 1, 2023, leaves must be curbside by 7:00 AM.

CURBSIDE ALUMINUM & GLASS COLLECTION

Have aluminum cans, glass bottles and jars (clear, green & brown) curbside by 7:00 AM on:

CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION

Collection will begin 7:00 AM on Monday, January 8, 2024. There will be ONE rotation through the Township.

> Be sure to remove garland, tinsel, ornaments, and lights. NO artificial trees will be collected.

BRUSH & YARD WASTE COLLECTION SCHEDULE Materials must be curbside by 7:00 AM on: 2023 2024 September 11th April 8th October 9th May 13th

MATERIALS COLLECTED (see PICTURE above)

- Wood sticks & branches less than six (6) inches in diameter (NO MAXIMUM LENGTHS)
- Vegetative or organic material produced from the care and maintenance of landscaped areas and gardens.

MUST BE CUT IN EIGHT (8) INCH LENGTHS. (NO PLANT ROOT BASE AND NON- VEGETATIVE MATERIALS)

- Weeds & Leaves
- Dead flowers and plants

MATERIALS NOT COLLECTED (see PICTURE above)

- Piles mixed with brush and yard waste
- Collected grass clippings
- Sod, Dirt, Rocks, Logs/Firewood
- Lumber/Construction material
- Root balls & Wood chips
- Tree/Brush stumps/Stump grindings
- Branches greater than six (6) inches in diameter
- Landscaping timbers

BRUSH & YARD WASTE COLLECTION GUIDELINES

- 1. The collection date for a property is dependent upon weather conditions and volume of collection.
- 2. Materials must be generated on the parcel where collection is placed.
- 3. Brush and yard waste must be in separated piles.
- 4. Brush must be placed with cut ends facing the street. Piles should not be compacted, bagged, placed in collection containers, tarped, or tied in bundles. ARM **FULL SIZE (see PICTURE above)**
- 5. Piles must be placed 3 feet from the paved portion of a public street and/or sidewalk. Do not obstruct drainage areas or place near stationary objects (e.g., mailboxes, fences, hydrants, utility poles, parked cars, trees, etc.).
- 6. Service is provided on every public street **ONE** time during a collection cycle.
- 7. Failure to follow guidelines will result in non-collection.
- 8. Property owner/occupant will be responsible for disposal of brush and yard waste not removed due to failure to follow collection guidelines.
- 9. Removal of materials by the owner/occupant must be completed within 15 days of the date of written notice by the Township, which shall be sent by 1st class mail to the address upon which brush and/or yard waste is located.
- 10. Materials generated by construction; commercial tree & landscaping services must be disposed by the company within 15 days of the date of completion.
- 11. Township employees will not enter private property to collect brush or yard waste.
