

East Buffalo Township Brush & Yard Waste Curbside Collection



2026 COLLECTION

Please place Brush & Yard Waste at the curbside by 7:00 AM on:

April 13th May 11th September 14th October 12th

Collection of brush and yard waste throughout the Township begins on the dates provided.

The specific collection date for your residence is dependent upon weather conditions and the volume of brush and garden waste in need of collection.

The Public Works Crew follows a regular rotation that collects on each street, one time during each collection cycle. Township employees will not enter private property to collect brush and yard waste.

COLLECTION GUIDELINES

Believe it or not, there is a right way and a wrong way to set out brush for pick-up. Following these guidelines will help you avoid common problems and allow us to better serve you and your neighbors.

BRUSH MATERIALS

Wood sticks & branches are less than six (6) inches in diameter.

(NO MAXIMUM LENGTHS)

YARD WASTE MATERIALS

Vegetative or organic material produced from the care and maintenance of landscape areas and gardens.

MUST BE CUT IN EIGHT (8) INCH LENGTHS.

Weeds & Leaves
Dead flowers and plants

COLLECTION NOTES

- 1. The collection date for a property is dependent upon weather conditions and volume of collection.
- 2. Materials must be generated on the parcel where collection is placed.
- 3. Brush and yard waste must be in separated piles.
- 4. Brush must be placed with cut ends facing the street. Piles should not be compacted, bagged, placed in collection containers, tarped or tied in bundles. NO LARGER THAN ARM FULL SIZE PILES.
- 5. Piles must be placed 3 feet from the paved portion of a public street and/or sidewalk. Do not obstruct drainage areas or place near stationary objects (e.g., mailboxes, fences, hydrants, utility poles, parked cars, trees, etc.).
- 6. Service is provide on every public street **ONE** time during a collection cycle.
- 7. Failure to follow guidelines will result in non-collection.
- 8. Property owner/occupant will be responsible for disposal of brush and yard waste not removed due to failure to follow collection guidelines.
- 9. Removal of materials by the owner/occupant must be completed within 15 days of the date of written notice by the Township. This shall be sent by 1st class mail to the address upon which brush and/or yard waste is located.
- 10. Materials generated by construction, commercial tree & landscaping services must be disposed of by the company within 15 days of the date of completion.
- 11. Township employees will not enter private property to collect brush or yard waste.

FOR EAST BUFFALO TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS ONLY: To use the East Buffalo Township Brush & Yard Waste Drop-Off site, you will need to stop by the Township Office and get a permit. You must show your current driver's license to the office to be issued a permit.

East Buffalo Township is required under Act 101 of 1988 to implement recycling programs. Commercial and institutional establishments are required to recycle glass, corrugated carboard, and high-grade office paper. Residents are required, by Township ordinance, to recycle, at a minimum, glass, aluminum, newspaper, plastics, leaves, trees, and shrub waste.

Place trees curbside by 7 AM, Monday January 12, 2026

- Remove garland, tinsel, ornaments and lights.
 - No artificial trees are collected

LEAVES

Curbside Collection will begin Monday, October 12, 2026.

Final Collection Cycle begins **Monday, December 7, 2026**.

Leaves must be curbside at **7 AM**.

- > Piles with sticks or other debris will not be collected.
- Avoid placing piles in drainage areas, on roads, or sidewalks.
- Avoid placing piles close to stationary objects (e.g. mailboxes, fences, hydrants, utility poles. Parked cars, trees).
- Maintain safe distances from vacuum truck.
