Curbside Collection will be on **Tuesday, April 7***. Residents need to have their recycling materials along the curb by 7am. Includes aluminum cans and glass bottles and jars (clear, green & brown).

Happening Now and Looking Ahead

The Public Works Crew started its street sweeping project. The Crew follows a regular rotation sweeping on each street, one time during each cycle. Township employees **will not enter private property or private streets.**

Comcast and Windstream are working in the Township running new cable services both over head and underground. They are leaving door hangers on doors if current resident/property owner is unavailable to talk to.

Tyler Technologies Field Data Collectors are visiting residential and agricultural properties. They will be wearing high visibility yellow vests along with a county ID Badge. The company name and logo are on the front and back of the vest.

PA State Dog Warden Hannah Ross for Snyder and Union County will be cracking down on dog licenses in the area and will be doing big canvasses checking for dog licenses and proof of rabies vaccines.
