TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE REMINDERS:

Please remember to follow the Township Ordinances as you plan your outside summer activities.

The **Animal Ordinance: Chapter 2**, please remember to keep them on a leash if you are out walking them in public. Most importantly...clean up after them. If you have pets outside, please make sure they have proper shade, food, and water.

The **Property Maintenance Ordinance: Chapter 5, Part 6**, keeping your property maintained. If you or your neighbor is struggling, be kind, reach out and see if you can help them or if they can help you. Life is so much easier when we can all work together.

The **Burning Ordinance: Chapter 7, Part 1**, absolutely **“No burning trash, brush, or yard waste material”** in the township unless approved by the Fire Department and Township. **All residents are required to recycle.**

I know some of us like to have campfires. It must be in a firepit, and flames must be kept under control.

The **Noise Ordinance: Chapter 10, Part 3**, all outside activities or work are not allowed before 7:00 AM and must end by 10:00 PM unless it is an emergency or it is approved by the township.

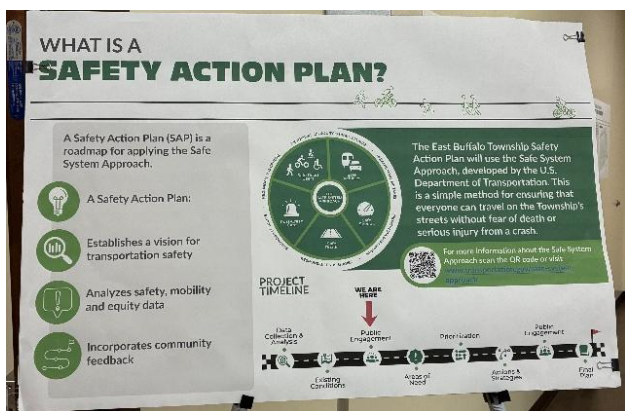
*****HAPPENING NOW AND LOOKING AHEAD***:**

Road work continues: **South 7th Street** from River Road to Moore Avenue; **Lan Avon Drive** from River Road South entrance to River Road North entrance; and **River Road** from US 15 (West Branch Highway) to Township Line (behind Bucknell University). The Public Works Crew will also be finishing the Turtle Creek Road Bridge Project, will be doing a lot of road mowing, regrading of ditch and regrading swale.

PennDOT has notified the township that they will be doing some work on US 15 (West Branch Highway) from the Marine Corps League Memorial Highway sign to Old School House Road approximately 3.07 miles of roadway they will be resurfacing from May 1st to June 30th.

Real Estate Tax penalty period starts June 1st to the end of year. School Taxes come out at the end of June, watch your mailboxes. Discount period starts July 1st to August 31st.
