Time: 5:00 – 6:30 PM

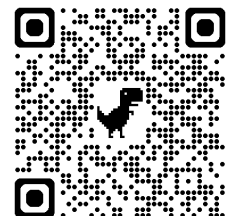
Location: East Buffalo Township Municipal Building, 589 Fairground Road
