HAPPENING NOW AND LOOKING AHEAD:

The Township Office Building and Public Work Garage will be closed on **Friday, July 3rd**, for Independence Day (July 4th) and will reopen on **Monday, July 6th**.

Thermoplastic markings (stop bars, turn arrows, etc.) schedule for the week of **July 6th**. Slow down, watch for stop traffic or slow-moving traffic. Do not pass.

Road work continues: **South 7th Street** from River Road to Moore Avenue; **Lan Avon Drive** from River Road South entrance to River Road North entrance; and **River Road** from US 15 (West Branch Highway to Township Line (behind Bucknell University)). The Public Works Crew will also be finishing the Turtle Creek Road Bridge Project and will continue road grading, and ditch/swale regrading.

NEW HOURS FOR TAX COLLECTOR:

July, September, October, November, and December hours will be 3rd and 4th Wednesday from 9:00AM to 1:00PM.

August 17th, 18th, 19th, 24th, 25th, and 26th from 9:00AM to 1:00PM.

School Tax discount period starts July 1st to August 31st. **Real Estate Tax penalty period** continues until the end of year.
