ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE OF EAST BUFFALO TOWNSHIP, UNION COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING CHAPTER 13 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF EAST BUFFALO TOWNSHIP REGARDING TRANSIENT RETAIL MERCHANTS AND MOBILE FOOD VENDORS IN EAST BUFFALO TOWNSHIP, UNION COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF EAST BUFFALO TOWNSHIP AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY AUTHORITY OF THE SAME AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Chapter 13, Part 3, Section 301 of The Code of Ordinances of East Buffalo Township, Union County, Pennsylvania, is hereby amended to provide as follows:

§301. Definitions.

ENFORCEMENT OFFICER – The Township Supervisors, Township Secretary and Township Manager, Central Keystone Council of Governments personnel, local police officers having jurisdiction, as well as any officer designated by the Township Board of Supervisors, from time to time.

§302. Applications for License. Every Transient Retail Merchant and Mobile Food Vendor in East Buffalo Township shall first make application at the East Buffalo Township Municipal Building to the Secretary of the said Township for a license. Upon such application each Transient Retail Merchant and Mobile Food Vendor shall provide the following: name, address, previous criminal record, if any, the names of the persons or entity for whom they work if any, the type of goods, wares, and merchandise they wish to sell or the entity for whom they are soliciting, the specific dates for which they wish to sell, solicit or take orders, the make,

model, color and registration information for the vehicle(s) to be used, if any. The License shall expire 90 days from the date of issuance.

(1) No license under this Ordinance shall be transferable from one person or entity to another, and every applicant must sign their application for a license and sign the license issued.

(2) Applicants for a Mobile Food Vendor license shall also provide a written statement, acceptable to the Township, indicating that the Mobile Food Vendor shall comply with all state regulations regarding the disposal of wastewater and grease. If the wastewater and grease are to be disposed of in a facility not owned, operated or controlled by the applicant, an agreement for such disposal with the facility owner or operator shall be provided with the application.

§305. Prohibited Acts. The following shall apply to licensees:

(2) **Mobile Food Vendors.**

(p) Mobile Food Vendors may not operate between the hours of 9:00 o'clock P.M. and 8:00 o'clock A.M., Mobile Food Vendor facility cleanup activities must be completed by 9:30 o'clock P.M., and Mobile Food Vendor facilities must be removed from their location a minimum of every three (3) days and moved a distance of at least one thousand (1000') feet from the previous location of the facilities.

§307. Suspension of License. The Township Enforcement Officers, as defined herein, shall be authorized to deny, revoke or suspend operations for any Transient Retail Merchant or Mobile Food Vendor found to be in violation of the requirements of this Ordinance. Should a Township Enforcement Officer observe a violation of the requirements of this Ordinance, such Officer shall provide written notice of the same to the Transient Retail Merchant or Mobile Food Vendor. The Transient Retail Merchant or Mobile Food Vendor shall have two (2) days within which to remedy any violations. Subsequent violations shall subject any Transient Retail Merchant or Mobile Food Vendor to revocation of their license.

In the event any Transient Retail Merchant or Mobile Food Vendor license is revoked as provided herein, such Merchant or Vendor may apply for a new license no sooner than ninety (90) days after such revocation. Any such subsequent revocation shall be permanent.

**SECTION 2: ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES
INCONSISTENT HERewith ARE HEREBY REPEALED.**

SECTION 3: THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE EFFECTIVE UPON ADOPTION.

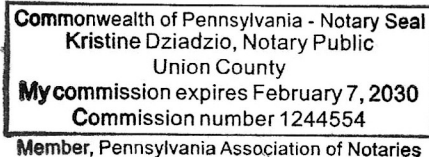
